
Where this transition manual deviates from University legislation, the University legislation will be taken as correct. You should always read them in addition to this manual in case information in the manual has become out-of-date.

What is the Facilities Development Committee?

The Facilities Development Committee (FDC) is responsible for issues relating to general space, functional programs, the design and use of facilities, and policies regarding facilities and planning.

Role in Governance Structures

FDC is a standing committee of GFC that can make recommendations to GFC and the Board of Governors. The President, Provost and Vice-President (Academic), and the Vice-President (Facilities and Operations) can bring any facility-related matters to the FDC for their consideration.
