





Experiential Learning Definitions

Work-Integrated Learning

Advanced Education's definition is drawn from Co-operative Education and Work-Integrated Learning Canada (CEWIL Canada): Work-Integrated Learning must be curricular (for credit), involve a partnership between the UofA, Industry/Community Partner and our students and take one of the following forms:

- Co-operative Education
- Internship
- Service Learning
- Field Placement
- Mandatory Clinical Placement
- Directed Field Study (only for applied degrees; none @ UofA)
- Other

Land-Based Learning

Following First Nations, Inuit and Métis ways of knowing, Land-Based education creates opportunities that acknowledge all the living relations who all co-exist on this land and the laws that govern those relations.

Research-Based Experiential Learning

- Research Assistantships (Grad and Undergrad)
 Employment at the University of Alberta that supports a specific research project.
- Creative Performance
- Directed Reading Courses
 Opportunities for in-depth exploration of a topic with minimal supervision from the instructor.
- Community-Engaged Research
 Connect disciplinary learning, skill development, and concepts through activities designed with a community organization to achieve mutually beneficial outcomes
- Other research experiences (paid or curricular)
 E.g. CURE (Course-Based Undergraduate Research Experience)

Innovative & Strategic Experiential Learning

Simulation Labs

Scenario-based learning in a structured environment that approximates a real-world setting

Competitions

Participation in events that showcases projects that address real-world problems.

Hackathons

A short and intensive challenge for teams of students to develop solutions to actual problems.

Laboratories

Participation in hands-on activities with a focus on skill acquisition and research.

Honours/Capstone Projects

A culminating experience that draws on learners' knowledge, skills, and abilities.

Case Studies

Applying theory to real-world or simulated cases

Studios

Apply theory to practice in a studio setting to demonstrate disciplinary learning and to reflect on the process and products of one's work.

Project-Based Learning

Develop complex problem-solving and teamwork skills by engaging with a real-world challenge in a course setting, typically with mentorship from an instructor.

Learning Communities

Communities of practice that supports learners interested in a similar topic.

Education Abroad

Learning that happens in another country and includes all possible experiences such as courses, faculty-led programs, internships, research, etc.
